## **Dashcam Hosting Agreement**

This Dashcam Hosting Agreement ("Agreement") identifies the rights, obligations, and promises made by and between Owner ("Owner") and Host ("Host") for operating a Hivemapper Dashcam ("Dashcam") in Host's vehicle.

This is a legally binding contract, having the following terms:

#### Dashcam Owner (Owner):

**Owner:** Beflo Limited (Trading as Future Networks)

Owner email: support@futurenetworks.host

**Dashcam Host (Host):** the individual or legal entity completing the form and ticking the checkbox to signify acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Agreement on the website <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration</a>, in order to become a Hivemapper Dashcam Host.

Host name: as indicated upon registration on the website https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration.

Host email: as indicated upon registration on the website <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration</a>.

**Host phone number:** as indicated upon registration on the website <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration</a>.

Host wallet: Host's unique Honey token-compatible wallet, to which automated weekly payments shall be sent.

## Monthly Fee payable by Owner to Host, in Honey tokens:

- 20% of the Honey tokens earned in association with the Dashcam provided by Owner to Host, for the payment period. Owner may increase the Host's percentage share of the Honey tokens at any time, but shall not decrease them below the 20% level.

**Effective Date:** This Agreement comes into force upon Host's successful submission of the form and ticking the checkbox to signify acceptance of the terms and conditions of this Agreement on the website <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration</a>, as well as the successful completion of the subsequent ID verification process. By checking the checkbox "I agree to the terms and conditions of the Dashcam Hosting Agreement" during form submission on the website <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/registration</a>, Host agrees to the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

**Duration:** The Agreement rolls each calendar month until either side gives notice.

Payment Cycle: Weekly, and on an automated basis.

### 1. OPERATION RIGHTS.

In exchange for the mutual promises and covenants herein, Host hereby grants to Owner the right, license and ability to operate the Dashcam in their vehicle. Ownership of the Dashcam remains with Owner.

# 2. HOST.

Host represents, warrants, and agrees the following:

- a. Host has the right and ability to operate the Dashcam in the vehicle in which they intend to place the Dashcam. Host shall not operate any Hivenmapper Dashcam in their vehicle except on behalf of Owner during the term of this Agreement.
- b. Host will take reasonable measures to ensure continued operation of the Dashcam in the vehicle in which the Dashcam is installed, which, at a minimum, includes maintaining power and Internet access to the Dashcam while using the vehicle in which it has been installed, and ensuring the mapping data collected is uploaded to the Hivemapper app within 24 hours of its collection, while this Agreement is in effect.

- c. Host shall set up the Dashcam on the inside of their vehicle, attached to the front windscreen, pointing forwards (unless otherwise instructed) towards the road, without anything obstructing the images of the road taken by the Dashcam, following the instructions provided by Owner to the best of their ability. Host shall set up the Dashcam within a reasonable amount of time which, unless agreed otherwise, shall be within four (4) days of receipt of the Dashcam by Host. A £2 fee for every day past this setup limit shall be deducted from Host's future earnings (using the honey USD exchange rate(s) on each individual day to calculate the exact amount of \$honey tokens to be deducted from Host's earnings).
- d. Host shall modify the position of the Dashcam as requested by Owner within four (4) days of such a request being sent by Owner to Host.
- e. Host shall start uploading mapping data within 7 days of receipt of the Dashcam, and shall ensure that all mapping data collected is uploaded to the Hivemapper app within 24 hours of its collection, while this Agreement is in effect. Host shall inform Owner of any issues that arise with regard to their ability to drive, ability to connect to the Dashcam, ability to upload the mapping imagery collected, or any other difficulties that might interfere with Host's ability to contribute to the Hivemapper map, within three (3) days of becoming aware of such an issue. A £2 fee for every day past this limit shall be deducted from Host's earnings (using the honey USD exchange rate(s) on each individual day to calculate the exact amount of \$honey tokens to be deducted from Host's earnings). If more than 2 weeks pass with less than 25km of mapping data being uploaded, Owner is also entitled to claim back honey, either previously earned or honey that is earned at a future date, from Host, at the penalty amounts outlined at <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/freezing-and-penalties/">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/freezing-and-penalties/</a>. It is reasonable for Host to stop using the dascham for periods of time due to vacation, being out of work, or other reasons, and Host shall inform Owner about such situations within 3 days of becoming aware of such a situation. If such time periods last for over 2 weeks, it is at Owner's discretion to either impose or waive the penalties outlined at <a href="https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/freezing-and-penalties/">https://dashcam.futurenetworks.host/freezing-and-penalties/</a>.
- f. Host shall allocate and keep free 20GB of memory on their mobile phone from which they connect to the Dashcam, at all times. This is easy to configure from within the Hivemapper app, and Owner shall provide any necessary assistance with this process or any other issues relating to setting up the Dashcam.
- g. Host shall take reasonable measures to ensure the quality of the mapping imagery collected by the Dashcam, including keeping a clean windscreen at all times, and periodically cleaning the lens of the Dashcam with a microfibre cloth.
- h. Host agrees to take reasonable measures to protect and not damage the Dashcam, and is fully responsible for the safety, whereabouts and condition of the Dashcam for the duration of this Agreement. Host shall not grant use or possession of the Dashcam to anyone else. If the Dashcam or any of its components are damaged, lost, stolen or sold as a result of negligent actions by Host, Host shall be liable to pay owner a penalty payment of up to £450, by bank transfer, to an account specified by Host, within 7 days of receiving written request for such a payment to be made. **The penalty payment shall not apply if the Dashcam stops working for reasons outside Host's control.** If the Dashcam stops working (i.e. is unable to earn \$Honey tokens) for any reason, Host shall inform Owner about the issue within 3 days of becoming aware of the issue. A £2 fee for every day past this limit shall be deducted from Host's earnings (using the honey USD exchange rate(s) on each individual day to calculate the exact amount of \$honey tokens to be deducted from Host's earnings).
- i. Host will be responsible for all personal taxes related to payments received from operating the Dashcam.
- i. Host has no claims on assets connected to the Dashcam including but not limited to mapping data collected.
- k. Host shall, upon request of Owner, provide digital photographs of the Dashcam, clearly demonstrating its location, physical condition, and proving that it is still in Host's possession, within 5 calendar days of such a request. A £2 fee for every day past this limit shall be deducted from Host's earnings (using the honey USD exchange rate(s) on each individual day to calculate the exact amount of \$honey tokens to be deducted from Host's earnings). Such a request cannot be made by Owner more frequently than once per 2 month period, except to follow up on previously unanswered requests. Failure to provide photographic evidence of the Dashcam in Host's possession within 30 days of the initial request shall result in the penalty charge of up to £450 outlined in point 2.h of this Agreement being implemented, and shall be paid within 7 days of receipt of such a request to pay the penalty charge.

- I. Host takes full responsibility for ensuring compliance with local rules and regulations while operating the Dashcam. Host also takes full responsibility for any risks associated with the installation and operation of such equipment, which include but are not limited to damage to property or person during installation and operation. Host understands that Owner is in no way responsible for the functioning of the dashcam or it's ability to operate as a way of recording images and / or videos that can be retrieved for the purpose of demonstrating lack of fault in case of accident, or any other purpose.
- m. Host shall return the Dashcam to Owner upon request by Owner, for any reason, within 7 days of receiving such a request to the Host's email address or phone number. In such cases, the Dashcam shall be sent via tracked courier or using the Royal Mail's 'Special Delivery Guaranteed by 1pm' service as advertised at <a href="https://www.royalmail.com/business/shipping/uk-services/special-delivery-guaranteed">https://www.royalmail.com/business/shipping/uk-services/special-delivery-guaranteed</a>, or an equivalent service, and all associated expenses shall be incurred by the Host. In such cases, Host shall provide tracking information to Owner. Host understands and accepts that the cost of return shipping is a risk they are incurring by entering into this Hivemapper Dashcam Hosting Agreement. Failure to return the dashcam to Owner within the 7 day period shall result in a £2 penalty for every day past the 7 day limit that Host does not return the dashcam to Owner and provide proof of postage on the aforementioned postal service (using the honey USD exchange rate(s) on each individual day to calculate the exact amount of \$honey tokens to be deducted from Host's earnings. If no honey is available from Host, the penalty fee shall be paid in GBP).
- n. Host shall securely store the box (packaging) in which the Dashcam arrives, as well as all components that are not used during installation. In case of returning the Dashcam to Owner, Host shall return the Dashcam and all components that arrived with the Dashcam within the box in which it arrived. Host shall be liable for up to £30 for losing the box and / or any and all of the components that arrived with the Dashcam.
- o. Host shall be expected to drive (and collect and upload mapping imagery from) a minimum of 150 miles of road per week.
- p. Each Dashcam shall be connected to a Solana 'master wallet' address of Owner. Host has no claims or rights to the tokens accrued in this 'master wallet', but only to the tokens which accrue in the wallet address to which Host's commission payments are sent. In the case that the tokens earned are accidentally sent to Host's personal solana wallet address instead of Owner's master wallet (due to technical errors, or any other cause), host shall return the difference between the total amount of tokens received and the amount of commission due to Host for the period, within 7 days of request by Owner.
- q. Host agrees that Owner has no responsibility for any issues with the Dashcam's hardware or software, as this is out of Host's hands. Host also bears no responsibility for any material, financial, or other losses, of any sort, caused by the dashcam.

# 3. OWNER.

Owner represents, warrants, and agrees that:

- a. Owner has the right and/or license to operate the Dashcam.
- B. Owner will do everything in their power to ensure that Host receives their share of the revenue generated by the Dashcam to their Wallet, in accordance with this agreement, and shall do everything in their power to rectify any issues with payments to Host, including miscalculations, non-payment, or any other payment related issues, within a reasonable timeframe.

Since all payments are processed automatically by Solana based smart contracts (code) written by Hivemapper Inc. and / or their partners, Owner shall not, however, be held liable for any such issues with payments to Host, as the process is largely out of Owner's control.

## 4. TERM and TERMINATION.

a. The Agreement rolls each calendar month until either side gives notice. This Agreement may be cancelled by either party at any time and for any reason by providing at least seven (7) days' notice prior to the end of the month.

- b. Within seven (7) days of termination of this Agreement for any reason, Host shall send the Dashcam to Owner's UK based physical address <u>at Host's expense</u>.
- c. Termination or expiration of this Agreement for any reason shall not relieve Owner of its obligations to pay all fees accrued and due prior to termination, nor shall it relieve Host of its obligation to return the Dashcam to Owner. Owner shall not owe any weekly fees after Termination of this Agreement and payment, in full, of any fees accrued prior to termination of the agreement.

### 5. NOTICES.

Notices shall be made by email to the email addresses provided above.

## 6. GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION.

Host and Owner agree that the laws of England and Wales shall apply to and govern this Agreement.

#### 7. ASSIGNMENT:

Host shall not assign or transfer, in whole or in part, its rights or obligations under this Agreement without Owner's prior written consent.

#### 8. NO PARTNERSHIP:

Nothing in the Agreement is intended to, nor shall it be deemed to, constitute a partnership or joint venture between Owner and Host, and neither party shall have authority to obligate or bind the other in any manner.

# 9. MODIFICATION:

This Agreement expresses fully the understanding between the parties. It may be modified by Owner at any time, however any changes made must be communicated in writing to Host at least fourteen (14) days prior to the change(s) coming into effect. In such a case, Host may dispute the changes made, but must do so within fourteen (14) days of receiving notification of such changes. A lack of response shall be deemed as acceptance of the new terms of this agreement. If Host wishes to terminate this agreement due to modifications made by Owner, Host shall not be obliged to pay the fee associated with returning the Dashcam. Instead, this fee shall be paid in full by Owner.
